Commissioners Oppose

Expansion; Want Ar

Otero County commissioners have sent a resolution to Cong. Ray Kogovsek (D-Colo.) opposing expansion of Fort Carson into the Pinon Canyon area, south of La Junta. Hearings on the expansion are being held this week in Washington D.C. At their meeting Monday afternoon at the courthouse the commissioners approved the resolution and urged other area residents to also send telegrams. Commissioners reported the toll free number to send a telegram which will be charged to the person's telephone bill is 1-800-257-2241. The resolution adopted by Otero commissioners states in part:

The proposed expansion of Fort Carson into the Pinon Canyon area will have a definite economic as well as environmental impact on our region. The Board of Commissioners for Otero County feels that the United States Army has attempted to minimize the detrimental impact of this expansion. U.S. Rep. Kogovsek has strongly opposed the Fort Carson expansion.

The Board of Commissioners strongly support the position advocated by Rep. Kogovsek, and greatly appreciate his efforts to protect the citizens of the Third Congressional District. + + +

SAVE SOUTHWEST LIMITED PETITIONS Through the efforts of Emmett Colosimo, La Junta, over 1,000 signatures had been collected on petitions which urge Kogovsek's support in working to save the Southwest Limited Amtrak train which goes through La Junta, Lamar and Trinidad. Colosimo, chief clerk in the Otero County Department of Social Services and Social Services Director Bill Ziegler presented the petitions to the commissioners on Monday asking them to forward them on to Cong.
